Overview

Sometimes a brand needs to have their own top-level custom fields for organizations. These can be created once in Dashboard, then each organization can have their own values input, and can use those custom field shortcodes like any others. Organization Custom Fields are separate from [Contact Custom Fields](#).

Settings and Navigation

Go to Dashboard > Tools > Configuration.

At the bottom of the **Settings** section, find the **Custom Fields** section. Click **Manage...**

Create an Organization Custom Field

The grid looks like the regular custom field grids and works the same way. You can edit or add custom fields. Instead of deleting, edit and make the custom field inactive. You can create categories and organize the fields that way - just click the Categories tab in the top right corner to edit those.
